

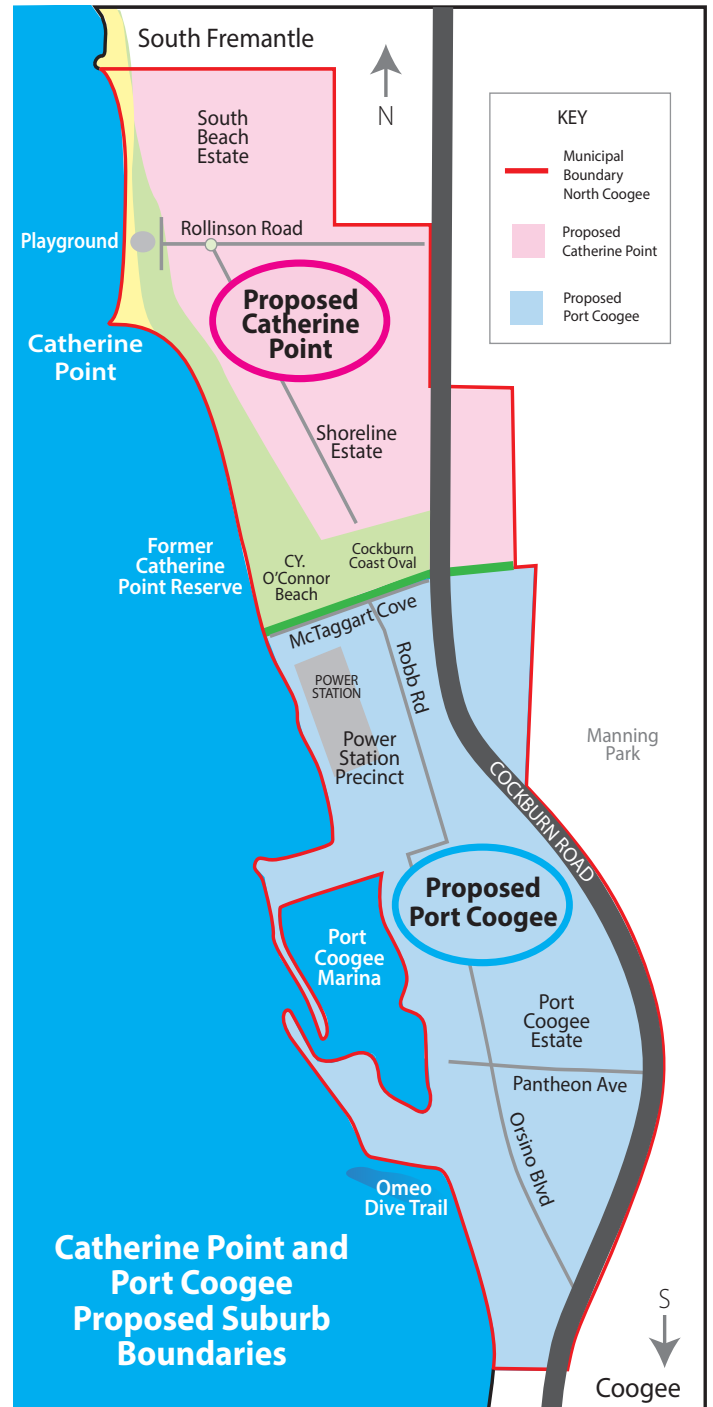
The proposed North Coogee Name Change

Where would the new boundary be located?

Why McTaggart Cove is the most appropriate boundary?

The present suburb of North Coogee would be divided at McTaggart Cove between the Power Station and CY O'Connor Reserve. This is a natural dividing boundary between the communities. Our suburb is a figure of eight with the narrowest part dividing north and south at McTaggart Cove. The CY O'Connor Reserve, the proposed Cockburn Coast oval and the Power Station clearly limit the easy connection between the two ends of the development. The Power Station, due to its scale and the need to move the Western Power infrastructure, is not likely to be developed for many years. Even then, it is doubtful that it could carry enough infrastructure to create an integrated connection between north and south.

Catherine Point groyne is very central to the top half of North Coogee and is more closely aligned to the North Coogee Dog Beach than CY O'Connor Beach. The Beach Emergency Number (BEN) CKB3 marks the location as Catherine Point on the footpath.
